Event proceeds support **ABCD youth programs** that provide a paid job, career development, and mentoring to help under-resourced young people build a better future.



SUMMERWORKS

Provides career skills, job readiness workshops, mentoring, social supports, and paid internships at partner worksites. Open to income-eligible Boston residents ages 14-24.



WORKSMART

Offers paid internships at partner worksites, career readiness classes, academic support, and social support. For income-eligible Boston residents ages 14-21 who are in school.



CAREER EXPLORATIONS

Participants prepare for careers in early childhood education, human services, healthcare, and more through internships with worksite partners. Open to income-eligible Boston & Metro North residents ages 18-24 who are not in school or enrolled in a GED program.



LEVEL UP

Assists participants in entering careers in early childhood education, human services, and healthcare. Enrollees attend a local college for a certificate with support from ABCD, including tuition assistance, paid internships, childcare, T passes, IDs, and food. For income-eligible Boston youth ages 18-24 not in high school or college or working full-time.
